Climate & Soil

- lowa temperature averages 21°F in January and 76.5°F in July. The annual average temperature ranges from a low of 11°F to a high of 86°F.
- · lowa's average precipitation is 35.7".
- lowa is the 2nd windiest state generating more than one-third of net electricity from wind.
- The lowa state soil is a series called "Tama."
- · lowa has at least 11,000 different soils.
- lowa has some of the richest and most productive soil in the world.

Crops & Livestock

- lowa ranks 1st in the U.S. in corn and 1st soybean production.
- lowa farmers harvested 13.5 million acres of corn (2.7 billion bushels) in 2016. lowa corn crop values \$8.8 billion.
- lowa harvested 9.45 million acres of soybeans (571.7 million bushels), in 2016, which valued \$5.3 billion
- Livestock in Iowa consumes 461 million bushels of Iowa Grown corn annually.
- · lowa leads the nation in hog and egg production.
- Over 240 million pounds of cheese are made in lowa per year.
- There are 22.4 million hogs (almost 32% of the nation's hogs), 3.9 million cattle, 175,000 sheep and 60 million chickens in Iowa. Iowa chickens laid 16 billion eggs in 2016.
- lowa's dairy industry produced an estimated 5 billion pounds of milk in 2016. The average milk produced per cow was 23,634 pounds.
- lowa ranks second nationally in red meat production. In 2016, 7 billion pounds of red meat were produced.
- The 165 thousand sheep shorn in 2016 produced 900 thousand pounds of wool. lowa ranks tenth in wool production.
- Nearly one-third of the nation's hogs are raised in Iowa. Exports of pork from Iowa totaled more than \$1 billion in 2016.
- In 2016, a little more than 11.7 million turkeys were produced in Iowa, many of which supplied the turkey for Subway restaurants.

General

- lowa has 55,875 square miles of land. Over 85% of lowa's land is used for agriculture.
- lowa ranked 2nd in 2015 in the nation in farm cash receipts at \$35 billion.
- lowa's 43 ethanol plants have a combined annual capacity of 4 billion gallons of ethanol annually. lowa produces more than 30% of the nation's ethanol.
- lowa ranks second in total agricultural exports. lowa farmers exported more than \$11 billion worth of agricultural products in 2015.
